**RESOLUTION R26-50 A RESOLUTION APPROVING
"BRING YOUR DOG TO WORK DAY FRIDAYS"**

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the importance of fostering a positive and engaging workplace environment; and WHEREAS, initiatives that support employee morale and well-being can enhance productivity and job satisfaction; and WHEREAS, allowing employees to bring their dogs to work on designated days may contribute to a more enjoyable and collaborative workplace culture; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners: Section 1. Approval. The County hereby approves the implementation of a voluntary "Bring Your Dog to Work Day Fridays" program at designated County facilities. Section 2. Administration. The County Administrator, in coordination with Human Resources and Risk Management, is directed to develop and implement policies, procedures, and guidelines necessary to ensure safe and orderly participation. Section 3. Requirements. Participation in the program shall be subject to requirements including, but not limited to, proof of vaccinations, appropriate behavior standards, and adherence to designated pet-friendly areas. Section 4. Liability. Employees participating in the program may be required to sign waivers acknowledging responsibility for their pets. Section 5. Effective Date.
